Description The Environmental Science and Engineering (ESE) Program offers a coherent program of education and research spanning the large scales of global climate studies to the local scales of engineering solutions to environmental problems such as toxic waste remediation. Reflecting the interdisciplinary nature of environmental science and engineering, the ESE Program unites scientists from Caltech's Division of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering, Division of Engineering and Applied Sciences, and Division of Geological and Planetary Sciences in studies of the functioning and coupling of the atmosphere, hydrosphere, biosphere, and lithosphere. Research in the ESE Program addresses, for example, air and water quality, past and potential future climate changes, and the dynamics of biogeochemical cycles and ecosystems (see the faculty pages). The methods employed in research projects include laboratory studies of fundamental chemical and biological processes; field studies of soil microbiology and of atmospheric chemistry; and computational modeling of chemical and physical processes on molecular to global scales. In addition to the facilities of individual research groups, staff and students in the ESE Program have access to a number of shared facilities, including the Environmental Analysis Center, the Center for Advanced Computing Research, and facilities at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory.

Description The Environmental Science major is a rigorous interdisciplinary program involving course work in biology, chemistry, physics and environmental science and engineering. Environmental science classes focus on theoretical and technical knowledge of the generation, transport and fate of pollutants, their impacts on natural resources and human health, and resource management, and conveying technical information. Laboratory courses are designed to maximize hands-on experience in collecting samples from various media, and using an array of equipment to characterize samples of soils, water, and air. Many of the environmental science courses include field trips to the adjacent Ballona Wetlands and Santa Monica Bay to demonstrate methods of collecting samples, and to study environmental conditions and resident biota. Internships with local environmental organizations and companies are an integral component of the program. The major requires that the student conduct a research project followed by presentation of results upon completion.

Description The Southern California Environmental Health Sciences Center, established in 1996, is comprised of researchers and professionals from the University of Southern California, the University of California at Los Angeles, and the California Institute of Technology. Together they have created an interdisciplinary approach to the study and advancement of research in environmental health that focuses on using epidemiologic methods to study effects of the environment on human health. The Center supports numerous programs including an Environmental Health Research Pilots Project and a Community Outreach and Education Program. Funded by the National Institute for Environmental Health Sciences, the Center is a joint program of USC and UCLA faculty. Researchers use epidemiological methods to study the effects of the environment on human health. SCEHSC researchers focus primarily on the health of the multiethnic populations of California and the Pacific Rim. A major part of the Center's mission is to advance the field of environmental health sciences. The Center supports pilot projects, maintains an active community outreach and education program, and publicizes its research findings to facilitate an informed public dialogue and, ultimately, improved public policies.
