Do I need a permit?

It can sometimes be difficult to determine what type of project will require a permit. Of course, new construction or significant remodeling work will require a permit, but if you are doing something less involved such as installing light fixtures, painting or cosmetic improvements, you may not know what is required. The LAEDC will work with you to contact the appropriate city/county/state offices to determine the requirements.

What to expect - helpful tips to keep in mind.

You will need to complete a permit application, and be prepared to pay the required permit fees. The fees will vary from project to project, and it is helpful from a budgeting perspective to obtain a fee estimate in advance. To save time and avoid future roadblocks, we often recommend a pre-submittal meeting with the permitting agency staff to conduct a preliminary review of the proposed project, and identify issues that can be corrected prior to the formal submittal. It may be necessary for many departments within the jurisdiction to review the application, so it is best to include representatives from each department to participate in this meeting. During this meeting, you can also determine an estimated approval timeline so that all parties are clear on the length of time needed to obtain the permit. This helps with project planning and avoiding unexpected delays.

How long will it take to obtain a permit?

The length of time required to approve a permit will depend on the complexity and the location of the project. Every jurisdiction has its own unique requirements, workload and staff availability that will impact the time it will take to issue a permit. Some permits can be obtained over the counter, but in most cases permits can take several weeks to several months.
