





Wonder Ventures and Techstars Ventures also participated in the round. Stasis Labs was incubated at the Cedars-Sinai Techstars accelerator. Stasis provides a full system for monitoring patients in the general wards of hospitals and in non-hospital care facilities. Home care is on their roadmap, but not for the near future. Stasis Labs: Taking care of patients outside ICU




