



#### CA Stay at home order issued March 19<sup>th</sup>

- Claims processed over the last six months are **more than triple** the worst full year of the Great Recession in 2010
- Extra \$600 federal stimulus payments ended July 25
- Federal approval for supplemental payment of \$300 per week from July 26th Aug 29th through LWA program



- Suspicion of fraud in PUA program through week ending Sept 5th




# August 2020 Employment in Los Angeles County






#### Home, Local, Professional, and Auto Services Prove Their Strength Amid the Pandemic

businesses have been struggling





Number of businesses marked closed on Yelp that were open March 1






## Business Closures in the U.S.
