The Four-Tier Reopening Plan...

Tier 1 WIDESPREAD

Many non-essential indoor business operations are closed

Tier 3 MODERATE

Some indoor business operations are open with modifications

Tier 2 SUBSTANTIAL

Some non-essential indoor business operations are closed

Tier 4 MINIMAL


Most indoor business operations are open with modifications

Total Cases Reported in LA County (4/14)


LA County now has 1,227,514 total confirmed cases (4/14)

Testing 7-Day Daily Average - Target: 15,000 Actual: 30,943-day average (4/15)

Testing Positivity Rate: 1.1% 7-day average (4/15)

Daily Deaths 7-Day Average – Target: No increase over past 14 days Actual: Down -77%


Daily Hospitalizations 3-Day Average – Target: No increase over past 14 days Actual: Down -21%

Current Hospitalizations: 3-Day Average: 508




Vaccine Distribution in LA County

(as of 4/6/21)



CA Stay at home order issued March 19th


- Claims processed through the pandemic reached 21.7 million
- Extra federal stimulus payment of \$300 started December 27th
- Total unemployment benefits paid to workers through the pandemic reach \$137 billion

Unique Claimants, Regular UI and PUA







Regular UI Claims filed week ending 3/14/20 through 4/10/21









NSA, Jan 2006 - March 2021










Monthly Change in the Unemployment Rate

Month-over-month change in nonfarm employment



Monthly Change in Payroll Employment by Sector Los Angeles County


Month-Over-Month Change in Jobs by Industry, March 2021 (NSA)






Yearly Change in Payroll Employment by Sector Los Angeles County

Year-Over-Year Change in Jobs by Industry, March 2019 through March 2021 (NSA)







In Los Angeles County


In **Los Angeles**, as of April 13 2021, total time spent away from home decreased by **10.8%** compared to January 2020.

Consumer Spending in Los Angeles


In **Los Angeles**, as of April 04 2021, total spending by all consumers decreased by **1.9**% compared to January 2020.





Small Business Revenue in Los Angeles


In **Los Angeles**, as of March 31 2021, total small business revenue decreased by **30.2**% compared to January 2020.

In **Los Angeles**, as of April 09 2021, total job postings decreased by **13.7**% compared to January 2020.
