


Launch of the 2025 California Foreign Direct Investment Report

A cornerstone of this year's summit, the FDI report revealed:

- 814,102 jobs in California supported by
- 18,693 foreign-owned enterprises, contributing
- \$89 billion in wages to Californians

This data underscores California's role as a magnet for global investment and LA's position as the gateway to opportunity. This year's analysis breaks down the Golden State into 13 regions (defined by the California Jobs First program) to give crucial insights for all Californians into how foreign investments create jobs in local communities.
